<p>Outline : Effective industrialization must be beneficial for developing regions and countries to reduce the poverty situation. However, economic development policy would be different from region to region due to various factors including natural resource endowment, technological advancement, and availability, supply chain, past history of industrial development, community agreement, consumer preference, etc. This course provides an opportunity to learn how these are different from place to place: among three countries/regions through cross-national interactive group work exercise.</p>
